

HERO AWARD INFORMATION SHEET

The Public Information Committee of the Nebraska Funeral Directors Association reviews and votes on all “Hero Award” nominations submitted to the Association. The Committee follows the criteria listed below in awarding the “Hero Award”. Only nominations fitting this criteria are to be submitted.

1. Nominee must have risked his/her life in the incident.
2. Whether the rescue effort was above and beyond the normal human responsibility.
3. Uniqueness of circumstances.

Note: It will be the responsibility of the funeral director submitting the application to investigate and verify the details of the incident so the Public Information Committee has correct facts on which to base their decision.

If the committee feels the nominee(s) action does not meet the Hero Award criteria, but feels their action was nonetheless worthy of recognition, the committee may award a “Certificate of Merit” which is sent directly to the nominee.
